Negelin County I^t Stephen Williams being of sound mind and memory
blessed be good for the same to make and publish his
last will and Testament. After my death all of my worldly estate
Machinery & after the following manners. I give to my beloved wife
during her natural life my plantation Wherow & all of my Cattle
horses, hogs & Sheep after her death to be divided as follows.
All the land that I have in the North East Side of Rock fish Creek
as far as the mouth of said Creek must be divided between
my three daughters Elizabeth Phelps and Judith, and all of my lands
lying on the South Side of Rock fish Creek as far as the mouth
of said Creek I give to my grandson James S. Johnson and all of
my lands lying in Taylors Creek I give to my grandson George
Washington Williams. After the death of my wife my stocks to be
divided as follows. I give to my grandson James S. Johnson
and three of my daughters to wit Elizabeth Phelps & Judith, one
half of my stock of Cattle and Sheep and the remaining half of
Cattle and Sheep I give to my two daughters Bridget and Mary,
I give to my three daughters to wit Elizabeth Phelps and Judith
all of my stock of Horses and Hogs.

As for daughter Mary it is my desire that she remain with my grandson
James S. Johnson or her three Sisters to wit Elizabeth Phelps and Judith
(at his pleasure) and that they furnish her every comfortable
necessity of life (but in no wise subject to the benefit of her
husband Isaac Wilson) but I have said to said son in my power
to emigrate from his three Sisters or my grandson whomsoever
there in that event they may guardian and three daughters
unmentioned shall not feel themselves bound by her marriage
Also in addition to what I have heretofore given my daughter Mary
I now give her the sum of One thousand dollars to my household
and Kitchen furniture growing interest &c & leave such
my wife and after her death my daughter Mary must have
one brother bed and my grandson James S. Johnson must have
one brother bed and its necessary furniture the remainder part
of my house hold and Kitchen furniture & family utensils
of all description I give to Elizabeth Phelps and Judith
for her own benefit.

Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Raynes the whole

the death of my wife must be divided between Elizabeth Phelps and
Judith but subject to the benefit of my surviving her natural
life I do hereby nominate & appoint to said my son in law
Stephen Williams and grandson James S. Johnson my executors to
this my last will and Testament this 23 day of May in the year of
One thousand eight hundred and forty

the money they are morgaged for on Sow and Pigs and all of my
Sheep and all of my houses back property and Kitchen furniture and
Plantation tools or as much thereof as she may think sufficient
for her own benefit
