In the name of God amir. I Thomas Hicks. Being in perfect health and of sound mind and memory thanks be to God therefore and calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die have thought good to make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament. I give to my beloved wife I give the plantation wheron I now live and four Negros viz Rose, Pleasant, Grindene and Mingo together with five cows and calve a yoke of oxen a riding horse two sets and all the outer in the house and choice of the beds with the furniture thereunto belonging also as many plantation tools as is necessary for her agtis her own proper age and behoof during her life or while she remain my widow I also give her twenty head of hogs which hogs with the above mentioned cattle to be to her own disposal for ever. I also I bestow to my only daughter Rebekah Mills four Negroes viz: Philip, Phelia, Cloe and her Child and what cattle is in her care at my decease together with the plantation wheron she now lives for and during her natural life and the 8th plantation I also bestow to her present husband James Mills for the time his life. Item I give and bequeath to my grandson Shadrack Mills after the decease of my wife the plantation wheron I now live and a negro named Mingo after the decease of my wife to him his

heirs and assigns for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my granddaughter Bender Mills a bed and furniture and ten head of cattle to bear her heirs and assigns for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Shadrack Mills a bed and furniture and ten head of cattle to bear her heirs and assigns for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my grand children Rebekah Mills, Anna Mills, Louisa Mills, Betsy Mills and Sarah Mills ten head of cattle each to them their heirs and assigns for ever. Item I had the two before mentioned Negroes named Rose and Pleasant left to my wife after her decease by my daughter Rebekah Mills during her life and then to be appointed and one or two of my grand children to bear the others parts and the remaining part of my estate after my just debts and funeral charges are paid I leave to be equally divided amongst my living grandchildren at the discretion of my wife whom I have and ordain my Executrix of this my last will and testament together with Robert Sutherland jun. And I do hereby declare and promulgar this to be my last will and Testament hereby revoking and rescinding to make void all other wills by me made witness whereunto I have set my hand and seal in presence of us. I Sherman Roots of Duplin County in the state of North Carolina, being now about seventy years of age and finding myself fast declining in my bodily health, and afflicted with many of the infirmities incident to so advanced an age; But blessed with a Retaining Memory and reasonable Consideration & Reputation, and feeling a desire now to settle my temporal affaires, and to make such distribution of my property (which God has blessed me with) amongst my family, as now seems most just and agreeable to me. For this purpose I now make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament, in manner following; that is to say. First it is my will and desire that all my
