In the name of God Amen. The fiftenth day of April in the year of our Lord 1762 I William Blackborne of North Carolina and county of Duplin planter. Being very sick and wear in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for man once to die make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally first of all give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my body recommend to the earth to be buried in a christian like manner at the direction of my Ex^{ors} nothing devoting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as looking such modesty estate others with it hath pleased God to bless me in ^{this} life. I give demise and appoint of the same in manner and form following that is to say in the first place I give and bequeath to Lucy Haddock my eldest son both my plantations on the west side of Cohony the one that I now live on containing contain four hundred acres and the other contain fifty in manner & form appointed. I have with with all the right privileges and appurtenances there into belong or in any way appurtenance and having in my self full power and lawful authority to dispose of ~~same~~ ^{the} and do here by do warrant secure and defend the same from all lawful demands of any
