In witness where of I the said Anna Blackmore have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above given written Signed Sealed and delivered by the testator and for his last will and testament in presence of us who were present at the signing and sealing of the same W. Whaples David Evans.

In the name of God Amen - The fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord 1762 I William Blackbow of North Carolina and county of Duplin planter. Being very sick and near in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God for the same and caring to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for man once to die make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally first of all give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my body recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the direction of my execr nothing devoting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as looking such mortaly estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me ⁱⁿ life. I give demise and appoint of the same in manner and form following that it doth pay in the first place to give and bequeath to Serey Haddock my system son both my plantations on the west side of Cohay the one that I now live on containing contain four hundred acres and the other containing fifty in manner & form appointed. I here with with all the rights privilages and appertaining thereto belong or in any way appertaining and having in my self full power and lawful authority to dispose of ^{the} same and do here by do warrant secure and defend the same from all lawfull demands of any

person or persons who so ever and said Jerry Hamock I make and
 constitute my soul and body creator executors and the said Jerry Hamock
 is to pay the just rentals of said lands from the above written date &
 the above said Jerry Hamock in memory his grand mother Martha
 Blackborn of the improvements of the plantation & now live upon
 during her life with all the privileges there unto belonging & give &
 bequeath to my honored mother Martha Blackborn one bed and
 furniture one brokiron two pots & one frying pan one bayson one
 dish on two plates one dozen of spoons two drags one great wheel
 one pr cotton cards two pairs one tub one piper one sifter and all
 the spun cotton and the cotton that is to spin two bottles one half
 a pint bottle one mug three cups the stilyards to my mother her
 life time and then to be returned to Jerry Hamock one candlestick
 , thoffer one Child to horses and one ox one grubbing hoe one plow
 implements for one testamant the book entituled the hole duty of man
 and the book entituled the seven pens I give to my mother six cows &
 calves four two year old steers two year old heifer my sonne
 three saddle & bridle mrs my hogs the remainder to be it to be diminished
 divided equally between my mother and Jerry that cap or sume
 forty to my mother & three to Jerry I give to Jerry two cows and calves
 two cows & one yearling — ~~two~~ year old heifer, one year old heifer
 one mare & colt one great pot, one dish on bayson one little shirt
 & one bed with one rug two sheets two earth drags two bottles three caps
 one broad ax one chisel two axes one rope one hand saw one fow
 one round shave one crimp one dogtoe one pr of irons one wedore one
 taper & one gimblet one gun one pr slinch irons one pair of bridle
 bits one toe. Willed and bequeathed ratified and confirmed this
 and no other to be this my last will and testament, and witness where
 unto I have set my hand and seal the day and year above
