Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Byrd one negro girl by the name of Candar to her heirs for ever, which she now has in her possession. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Patsy Hines one negro boy by the name of Antine to her and her heirs for ever which she has now in her possession. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Edith Frederick one negro by the name of Allie to her and her heirs for ever, which she now has in possession. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Gilmore one negro girl by the name of Clarissa to her & her heirs for ever, which she now has in possession. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Wilson one negro girl by the name of Abby to her & her heirs for ever which she now has in possession. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Patsy Gully one negro Woman by the name of Asa & her two children a boy called Brister and a girl by the name of Faby to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my son Jesse Gully one negro girl by the name of Anna to him and his heirs for ever, which he now has in his possession. Item I give bequeath to my two grand sons James & Henry Gully sons of William Gully Jr. each one silver dollar each and no more. Item I give & bequeath to my grand son William Daniel son of Sally Daniel one Hundred Dollars.
