 this my Last Will & Testament, that is to
 say First capotly & first of all I give & Recommend
 my Soul into the Hands of God that God
 will & so my Body I Recommend it to the Earth
 to be Buried in a Christian like Manner,
 at the Discretion of my Exors nothing
 Doubting but at the General Resurrection
 I shall receive the same Again by the Mighty
 Power of God and as Touching such Worldly Estate
 as I hath Pleased God to Bless me with in this
 Life I give Devise & Dispose of the same in
 Manner & form following that is to say
 I give & Bequeath unto my Son Aron the
 Feather Bed & Furniture that I lie on and
 also my Rifle Gun to him & his Heirs for
 ever I give & Bequeath to my Daughter
 Abigail two Hundred Acres of Land on the South
 Side of Brack Run at the upper End of a Survey
 that I took then & also on that her Old & Furniture
 to her & her Heirs and I give for ever -

I Give & Bequeath unto my Brother Jonathan Colman all the Remainder Part of that Survey of Land on the South Sd. of Back River between that I gave my Daughter & Usha Battledine to him & his Heirs for ever

I Give & Bequeath to my father Charles Colman all that Part of that Survey of Land that I took up that lies on the North Sd. of Back River to him & his Heirs & assigns for ever I leave all the Rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided between my Son & Daughter Aaron & Abigail & Devin that it may keep in hand for them I give my Stock of all Kind to be sold & the money to be divided to them & their Heirs for ever

I Also Constitute make & Ordain my father Charles Colman my only & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament & sole Heir by & by Disallow, Revoke & Disannul all & every other former Testaments, Wills & Legacies Requested & Given by me in any Way before this time Named Wills & Bequests Making & Confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament in Writing & that I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the Day & Year above Written Signed Sealed & Published & Declared by the said Charles Colman as his last Will & Testament in Presence of us, his Witnesses
