 Earth to be buried in a Christian like & Decent
 Manner at the Discretion of my Exors Nothing
 Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
 receive the same Again by the mighty Power
 of god and as Touching such worldly Estate
 Wherewith it hath Pleased god to Bless me in this
 Life I give Devise & Dispose of the same in the
 Manner & form following.

I give and Bequeath unto my Father Andrew
 Ross all my Real & Personal Estate all my
 Lands & Tenements goods & Chattels unto him
 by his Heirs & Assigns for ever
 And Lastly I Appoint my Aforeward Father Andrew
 Ross William Tucker William Pittman & James
 Stollens his & each of them of this my Last Will
 & Testament as Witness my Hand and Seal
 the Day & Year first above Written
