Swamp & to the Heirs of her Body lawfully  
Begotten & for Default of such Heirs to my  
Next Heir at Law my Will & Desire is that the  
Tract or Tracts of Land that fall to me by the  
Death of my Brother Moses Wall may be  
Equally Divided between my two Daughters  
Mary & Sanny Wall & to the Heirs of their  
Body lawfully Begotten & for Default of  
such Heirs to my Next Heir at Law my  
Will & Desire is that all my Stock of Cattle  
may be Equally Divided between my two Daughters  
Mary & Sanny Wall my Will and Desire  
is that the Remainder Part of my Estate not here  
mentioned may be Equally Divided Between  
my Dear Beloved wife Mother Wall & my two  
Daughters Mary & Sanny Wall and my  
Will & Desire is that John Jones & Charles Daugh  
may Stand my Executors.
