In the Name of God Amen I Edward Banner of the County of Edgecombe and Parish of St. Marys Blanter being infirm of Body but of Sound Mind memory Reasoned a. god for the same considering that it is appointed for all men once to Die hereby make & Give in this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following (Viz)

First I do commend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it hoping through the Merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ to obtain Full Pardon of all my Sins and my Body to the last forasmuch as I have made the Decent Buriall of the Disposition of my Goods hereafter to be Named and as to my Temporal Estate which with it I do bequeath to Joseph and Elizabeth my Wife I do Dispose thereof as followeth

First I give to my son Nathan Banner one Shilling & one Penny I give to my daughter Mary one Shilling & one Penny I give to my daughter Sarah one Shilling & one Penny I give to my daughter Elizabeth one Shilling & one Penny I give to my daughter Mary one Shilling & one Penny I give to my daughter Sarah one Shilling & one Penny I give to my daughter Elizabeth one Shilling & one Penny
