In the Name of God Amen The
twenty eight of December in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & fifty & Major
Hall of Edgecombe County being undisturbed
Disorder in my Body though in my Disposed
Mind & Memory and my proper Sense & Reason
be good for it and therefore calling to mind
the mortality of my Body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men Once to Die
do make and Ordain this my last Will
& Testament that is to say Principally
and first of all I Recommend my Soul into the
Hands of God that gave and for my Body
I Recommend it to Mr. Burth to be Buried in a
Christian like manner and Decent of the
Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting
but at the general Resurrection I shall Receive
the same Again by the mighty Power of God
and as touching such Things as my worldly
Estate when such I have & shall have

To Bless me with in this Life I give Deeds
 & Dispose of the same in following manner
 and form

To my eldest son Eliza Wall I give & Bequeath
 the Remainder of Plantation now live or to be
 coming Ninety Acres at Bungin Sage county
 giving of David Wall's Land.

To my second son Hardy Wall I give & Bequeath
 the Plantation where Sarah Wall did live
 containing Ninety Acres of Land it being part
 of the same tract of Land that Eliza Wall now
 lives on.

To my Well Beloved Wife I will & Bequeath
 the three parts of my Modest Estate of Land
 the first thereof to her during the time
 of her Life & Widowhood.

I likewise constitute make and Bequeath same
 Wright & Abraham as to my only son Eliza
 to this my last Will & Testament and also
 Ninety Acres of Land now in the hands of
 all & every other Testament with the same
 & give them or in any ways to be named
 with & Bequeath to the living & confirming this
 & no other to be my last Will & Testament
 In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
 Hand & Seal the Day & Year above written
 Signed & Given in presence of us
 Thomas Daniel

 Christy Wall
 Eliza Wall

Lord 1861 one thousand seven hundred & sixty one
I Henry Bond of Edgecombe County in the Province
of North Carolina Gent: being very sick & weak
in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks
be given unto God, therefore calling unto mind
the mortality of my Body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die I do make
& Ordain this my Last Will & Testament, that
is to say First I call up and first of all I give and
Recommend my Soul unto the Hands of God that gave
it and as for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth
to be Buried in a Christian like & Decent manner
at the Discretion of my Exors nothing Doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty Power of God and
