30th Daye December 1760. I Francis Lloyd of
Pidge comb in North Carolina being very sick
and weak in Body, but of perfect mind & memory
thankes be given to god. therefore calling to
mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make & Ordaine this my last Will & Testament
that is to say Principally & first of all give
I command my soul into the hands of God who
gave it and my body I command into the earth
to be buried in a Christian burial at the
Discretion of my Sons nothing doubting but
~~that~~ at the General Resurrection I shall rise
the same again by the mighty Power of
God and also touching such worldly Estate in this
world I call upon God to help me in the
disposition of my Sons nothing Doubting but
in the following manner & form.

I give and Bequeath unto Elizabeth my deare
Beloved wife on her death bed of summe time past
Leave her the use of my Plantation and land
and mill during her lifehood & then I give
Bequeath unto my Beloved son Francis Lloyd
the Plantation whereon I now live with my
Water mill and one hundred and forty acres of
land being the part of my land joyning on the
South side of Swift Creek. Also give him one Bed &
one young m...

I give and bequeath unto my Beloved Son George
Lloyd all the Remaining Part of my Land to him
and his Assigns also give him one young mare
also give him one feather Bed & Furniture —
I give to my Beloved Daughter Deborah Lloyd
one feather Bed and Furniture and I have the Use
of all the Rest of my Estate to my Mrs. Damer
her Heirs & Successors I give it to my
Children & Wives of them Lloyd George Lloyd &
Henry Lloyd Deborah Lloyd Lydia Lloyd and Elizabeth
Lloyd. Also I equally divide amongst them
and take care of and am my wife Elizabeth
Lloyd and my son George R. Lloyd Executors to
the my last Will & Testament & do utterly
disabllie & rescind Disannull all & every former
Gifts & legacies Wills and Bequests and Provisions
by me in Any place before named written
Bequeathings & Mating and Conveying these and
no other to either said Will and Testament
or Wills whereof I have herunto setting No 20
and seal the Day 8 year Person written

Disorder in my Body though in my perfect
Mind & memory and my open desire it is
begged for it and therefore troubling the mind
the Mortality of my Body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last Will
of Testament that is to say principally
and first of all recommend my soul unto the
Hands of God that gave and for my Body
I recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a
Christian like manner and decently
Dignation of my Estate following Doubtless
but at the general Resurrection that will occur
the same again by the mighty Power of God
and an troubling such things as my Friends
will see when their last Will & Testament
