Disputes in my Family about the Estate I may
Leave at my Death do make this my Last Will
and Testament, in manner following that is
to say:

I give and bequeath the Labour of my Negro man Sam to my
beloved Wife for and during the Term of Eight
Years and then I give my said Negro man Sam
to my son Bellajah Williamson but if my said
Son should happen to Die before he comes to the
Age Seventy one Years then I give my said
Negro man Sam to my Beloved Wife before mentioned

I give and bequeath to my said Son Bellajah
Williamson one Cow and Calf and one Sow & Piggs

I give and bequeath to my said Son Bellajah
Williamson & to his Heirs for Ever my Survey
of Land lying Durmon branch in Polk County
County

All the Remainder of my Estate of what Nature
or kind soever after my Just Debts & Legacies are
Paid and the Expenses of taking out the Deed
for the Land I have herein Given my said Son
I give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife before
mentioned

I nominate and Appoint Joseph Cotton the Elder Joseph Williamson
& Lawrence Williamson my Beloved Wife whole and sole Ex-
ors of this my Last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this 25 Day
of July 1701

In the Name of God Amen The Twenty fourth day of December 1760 I William Lewis of the County of Edgemoor being very sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind and Memory Thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my soul unto the Hand of God that gave it and for my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like Manner at the Discretion of my Exors without Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the mighty Power of God And so touching that worldly Estate which I have I bequeath I have God to bless me in this Life and hereafter and Dispose of the same in the following Manner and for use
