In the Name of God Amen. The Twenty sixth day of January in the year of our Lord 1861 one thousand seven hundred & sixty one I Henry Bond of Edgecombe County in the Province of North Carolina Gent: being very sick & weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God, therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament, that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul unto the Hands of God that gave it and as for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like & Decent manner at the Discretion of my Exors nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and

Do touching such worldly Estate which with
 a halcyon heart god to Bless me in this life I give
 Devises and Dispose of the same in the following
 Manner & form.

I Reserve to my Beloved Wife Susanor Bond
 the Use of the Plantation and Land whereon now
 I live also all my Negroes and all my money and all
 my Stock of all sorts & every other Thing that
 shall be called my Personalty During her Widowhood
 & no longer and afterwards to my Will & Devise
 that all my aforesaid Estate both that of Personal
 shall be Equally Divided between my three Brother
 eldest Sons to wit my Brother Lewis Bond his
 eldest Son on the one Part.

And my Brother Wm Bond whose dead has the
 Son Wm the other third Part.

And my Brother Wm Bond his eldest Son to have
 the other third Part.

To them their Heirs and assigns for ever
 and lastly I appoint my beloved Wife Susanor
 Bond and my dearly loved William Hammond
 to be my sole Executors of this my last Will & Testa-
 ment in all things whereof I have Power to
 sell my Land and that the day and year first
 above written they did read & published and pronounced
 by the said William Bond as his last Will & Testa-
 ment in presence of us
