in quiet Possession but her share of my Land and
Plantation not to be sold at Publick Sale and the
Money to be equally divided between my
Daughters Ruth Horn Merriam Horn and
Leah Horn for them to be Repaid with the
Money as soon as it is due.

That my wife & I desire that my wife Elizabeth Horn
should be Repaid with all
my Household Goods & Chattels and my Stock
of Cattle Hogs & horses during her life & after
her death it is my will & desire that the same
shall be sold & the Money equally divided between

All my Children vizt/ Leon Horn Josiah Horn
 Pinglope Nanny Ruth Horn Merrian Horn and
 Larniah Horn I do hereby constitute & appoint
 my Brother, Alford Horn John Scott &
 my well Beloved Wife Elizabeth Horn my
 Exors. of this my Last Will & Testament
 I do Wholly Disallow all other former Wills
 whatsoever and Acknowledge this to be my
 Last Will & Testament in Writing whereof
 I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal the Day
