 I James Cain of the County of Edgecombe
 being very sick & weak in Body but of perfect
 mind & memory Thanks be given to God
 therefore calling to mind the Mortality
 of my Body and knowing it is appointed
 for all men once to Die Do make & addain
 this my Last Will & Testament that is to
 say Principally & first of all I Recommend
 my Soul into the Hands of God that gave it
 and for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth
 to be Buried in a Christianlike Manner
 at the Discretion of my Heirs: Nothing
 Doubting but at the General Resurrection
 I shall Receive the Same Again by the Mighty
 Power of God and as touching such Wordly
 Estate wherewith I hath been & shall be God to
 bless me with in this Life I give Divide and
 Dispose of the Same in the following Manner
 To wit

I give & bequeath to my Daughter Deborah
 Cain one Negro Man called Sam & one Negro Girl
 called Joe & one ^{hope} Boy called Peter & one feather Bed
 & furniture & five Cows & Calves & also my Obed
 Riding Iron are to be disposed with at Eighteen ^{years}
 of Age
 I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Deborah
 one Negro Man called Sam & one Negro Girl called
 Dixie & one feather Bed and
 furniture and an Iron Wheel to be disposed with at
 Eighteen years of Age

Item To my Daughter Elizabeth Cair Egier and
76 Bequeth one Negro Girl called Minnie & one Negro
Boy called Daniel and one feather Bed & furniture
and one linen Wheel to be Possessed with at Eighteen
years of Age &c

Item To my Daughter Mary Cair Egier & Bequeth
one Negro Girl called Patti and one Negro Boy
called Jip & one feather Bed & furniture and five
Coats & Colls and one linen Wheel to be Possessed
with at the Age of Eighteen years &c

Item To my Son James Cair Egier & Bequeth the Plan-
tation and land Where now live containing Six
hundred & forty Acres and half of the Steadings
which land I give to him and his Heirs for ever
and also a Negro Boy called Ben a Negro man
called Jerry and my Shirt and Walnut Table and one
Gown & Patti and one great Billo & one Head of Cattle
and one young mare and a feather Bed and
Furniture

To my Daughter Ann Cair Egier & Bequeth one
Negro man called Tom and one Negro man called ^{Mark} Jerry
and a feather Bed & furniture & two large Pewter
Dishes and ten Head of Cattle to be Possessed with
at the age of Eighteen years &c

Item To my Son Wadd Cair Egier & Bequeth the Mill
and Plantation and a Hundred and fifty Acres of
land & Half my New Entry to him and his Heirs for
ever and one Negro man called Simon and one Negro
man called Ben and also ten Head of Cattle and one
young mare

Item. To my Son Jacob Cain I give & bequeath
a plantation and Tract of Land containing
200 Acres lying on the Riverdam Swamp and
a Tract of Land in Johnson County containing
320 Acres to him & his Heirs for ever and
an Negro Boy Named Jack and fifty Pounds
Virginia money to Purchase a Negro
and Six Pound Virginia Money to Purchase him
a Bed and Six Pound Virginia Money to buy him
some Cattle and one Iron ^{Stone} Pott and one Ruff Gun
There is a ^{he} ~~g~~ ^{man} called ^{John} which if Charles Davies
after a four night tryal I will the Purchase
him at the Price Agreed upon. He is to pay
the money do my Exors if not the Negro &
he Live is to be returned on to me and all the
Rest of my movable Estate to the Highest
Bidder and then I Desire all my Lawfull Debts
to be Paid and my three Sons to have three
years schooling a piece and the Rest of the
Money to be equally divided among my
Children

I do hereby constitute make & Ordain my Brother
in Law Edward Moore and my Brother in Law
William Walker my only Exors of this
my Last Will & Testament and do here by
thoroughly Disallow revoke & Disannul all and every
Other former Testaments Wills Legacies & Exors
by me in any Manner before then made & made
to bequeath & bequeathing & bequeathing
this and no other to be my Last Will and

Testament.
