December in the year of our Lord 1763 Edward Hallward
of Edgewood County in the Province of North Carolina
being weak and weak in Body but of perfect mind and
Memory thanks be given to God for the same and calling to mind
the Mortality of my Body and knowing that I am appointed
for all manner to do I make and declare in this my last
will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of
all I give and Recommend my soul to the hands of
God that gave it and for my Body I Recommend it to the
earth to be buried in a Christian and decent manner at the
Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
Generall Resurrection I shall Receive the same again
The mighty Power of God and touching my worldly
Estate I Recommend it to be divided as follows
I give and Recommend the same to my wife and family

following that is to say In presence my Devised
 is that all my Just Debt and funeral Charges be fully
 satisfied and Paid Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved
 wife Sarah Willard my Negroes as follows to wit a red
 Joppo and also land her the use of my negro girl & Venes
 till my Daughter Eliza both Willard come of age or day of
 Marriage & take land the use of my Plantation & here and
 now I will to her during her Widowhood only one half of the
 Orchard after my son Jeremiah Willard comes to the age
 of twenty and years & also give her one half of my house
 hold goods to be Equally Divided and my horse the red
 Tobee, quiver and Pomeroy and her old hat now wears
 with all my silver Cuckoo right Lane and Calver and two
 three year old Steers and two old breeding cows and
 thirty two year old Barrows and paid sums and all my
 Shingles and my Mixture of interest and thirty five
 Barrels of corn & take land her the use of one half of my Mill
 during her Widowhood & also give her five cows and twenty
 three pigs that is now and there all the above Bequeath
 Except them that she receives only Sent I give and Bequeath to
 her and her heirs and assigns forever Item I give and
 bequeath to my son Jeremiah Willard all my lands that
 I am possessed with except the use of the Plantation
 Land to my Wife during her Widowhood but that he is to
 have half the Orchard of the S. Plantation when he come
 to the age of twenty and years & I release him any Mill
 right excepting Cuckoo other what to my Wife during

her Widowhood I also give him my Negroes Jerry Hannan and
 sold all my Legacies to my son Jervis and Bequeath to him
 and his heirs and assigns forever I Item, I give and bequeath
 to my Daughter Elizabeth Hilliard my Negroes Sam and Davey
 and tend only she is not to have Tentstall she came to see
 self I do bequeath the Legacies to my Daughter Jervis and
 Bequeath to her and her heirs and assigns forever I Item
 I leave all the Remainder of my Estate that is not already
 given away, to be sold and the money equally divided between
 my son Jervis and Hilliard and my Daughter Elizabeth
 Hilliard to them and their heirs and assigns forever I
 my desired that the Hogg that I have as a farming tool
 silver and sundry of the left for the use of my family
 and the Rest of them to be sold to the Most advantageous use
 of my Executors I do hereby constitute make
 and appointing Thomas Blakewell Battle and
 Hilliard and Harrison of Henry my only and sole
 of the my Executors and Executors and I do hereby
 utterly revoke and Disannul all and every
 other former Will and Legacy Bequeath and Executors
 by me in any way before this time made and
 Bequeath Ratifying and confirming this and so
 What to be my last Will and Testament in Witness
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day
 and year above Written Jacob Hilliard Esq.
