And After all my Worldly Debts is paid —
 I Give to my Beloved Wife Mary Gay all my Estate
 her Life. Anne and After her Decease —
 I Give & Bequeath to my Eldest Sister Son —
 Thomas Pittman all my whole Estate to him
 & his Heirs for ever —
 And I do hereby these Presents Constitute and
 Appoint Joseph Pittman and Saml. my sol. & sol.
 Exor and I do Acknowledge this to be my last
 Will & Testament in Willems my State &
 Test this 2^d day Third Month in year of
 our Lord 1759
