and Bequeath in Manner and form following
It is my will that all my Just and Lawfull Debts
to Me and Several Charges

Thereof having advanced already according to my Ability
I therefore give him one Shilling Sterling

him and his for Ever to my Son John Williams
having advanced my son Robert Williams according

to Ability I therefore give him one Shilling Sterling
with him and his heirs for Ever

I give and Bequeath unto my son Joseph Williams one
Shilling Sterling to him and his heirs for Ever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah
 Withinson one Shilling Sterling to her and her
 heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Maria
 Paul one Shilling Sterling to her and her heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Martha
 Griffin my side Saddle to her & her heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath all the Part of my Estate
 to be Equally Divided between my two Grand
 Children Simon Simons & Pally Simons son and
 Daughter of my Son Joseph Simons to them
 and their Heirs for ever, And of this my

Will I make constitute nominate ordain and
 appoint my trusty and Well Beloved Son Joseph
 Simons my whole and sole Executor and
 annulling all former Wills by me herebefore
 made signing and confirming this and none other
 to be my last Will and Testament in Testimony
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my Seal the Day and Year first above Written
