Item All the Rest & Remainder of my Estate I bequeath
or kind whatsoever it be I leave to be sold to Discharge
my funeral Charges & my Debts.

Item I Appoint and Ordain my Uncle Lewis Perit
& my Uncle John Perit, my whole Executors
of this my Last Will & Testament.

Item if any Money or Money worth shall Remain
after my funeral Charges & Debts shall
be paid I give to my Nicholas Perit.
