In the name of God Amen this 11th Day
 of August in Decesay. I Ralph Vickers of the County
 of Wexcombe in the Parish of Saint Marions in the Province
 of North Carolina being very sick and weak in Body but
 in perfect mind and memory Blessed be God therefore
 calling to mind the frailty of my Body and the Certainty
 of Death Do make and Publish this my Last Will &
 Testament in manner as followeth Viz. First I recommend
 my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it
 nothing Doubting But at the Day of the Resurrection I
 shall receive it again and my Body to the earth to be interred
 with decent and Christian Burial at the Discretion of my
 Executors hereafter named and as touching what
 worldly Goods it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow
 with all I will and bequeath in manner and form as
 followeth Viz.

First I Do Will & Bequeath unto my Dearly beloved
 Wife Sarah the Plantation on which I now do Live for and
 during her Natural Life and at her Decesay I do Will &
 Bequeath the aforesaid Plantation to my youngest Son
 Abraham Vickers to him and his Heirs for ever. Item
 I do Will and Bequeath unto my Dearly beloved Son
 John Vickers that Tract of Land and Plantation which
 I bought of John Moor. to him & his Heirs for ever. Item
 unto my eldest Son Ralph Vickers. I give together with my
 Wife Sarah. I do bequeath my true Love & Lawful Goods
 & Estate to this my Last Will & Testament. I do Will &
 Bequeath that Tract of Land and Plantation which I
 bought of William Williamson to him and his Heirs
 for ever and further I do Will & Bequeath to my said
 Wife Sarah my best Bed and furniture and also the

nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall
because the same again live as touching such I hereby
doe command it shall please to be done with in the
life of God and together in manner and form following
I bequeath it to my dear daughter Abigail Vick as first
and then to her and with my loving wife many light
my children whom I name to with all my children
