Who gave it me where he shall think fitt to take me
here and my body to be as for what word by Estate it
hath pleased god to bless me with in this life I give
and bequeath in manner following. I give and
bequeath unto my beloved Son Will^m Huddnall twenty
pounds current money of North Carolina to be paid to him
after my Decease. I give and bequeath unto my
beloved Son Rob^t Huddnall fifteen pounds of current
money of North Carolina one half of my Cattle I bought of
W^m Holson to be paid to him after my decease. I give
and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary
the other half of the Cattle I bought of W^m Holson
and one hog more to be paid after my decease. I give
and bequeath unto my beloved Son John Huddnall
twenty pounds current money of North Carolina and one
heaven Colt called Silver to be paid him after my decease
I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Amos Huddnall
twenty five pounds current money of North Carolina

To be paid to him at the age of twenty one years
 I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter
 Lydia Rudnall twenty pounds current money
 of N^c Carolina and one feather bed and
 Furniture to be paid after my decease

I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter
 Mer^a Martha Rudnall twenty pounds current
 money of N^c Carolina and one feather bed and
 Furniture to be paid to her at the age of eighteen
 Year or marriage I give and bequeath unto my
 beloved son Willis Rudnall one hundred and
 Eighty three acres of Land on the N^e Side of Sything
 Creek in Edgecombe County to him and his heirs and
 one hundred pounds free money of N^c Carolina
 my watch one buchaner gun

I leave the use of my plantation that I bought of W^m
 Newman upon deep Creek unto my dearly beloved
 Wife Elizabeth Rudnall during her life and my reges
 and all and after her decease I bequeath them all
 to my son Willis Rudnall and I thus leave my
 Wife the use of all the remaining part of my estate
 of what soever kind it be during her natural life or
 widowhood and in case of her second marriage unto
 her out of her part of my estate I bequeath unto her
 fifty pounds current money of N^c Carolina and at
 death or marriage and all the remaining part
 of my estate in her possession to be equally divided
 among all my children then alive

I did appoint and ordain my wife Elizabeth
 Rudnall and my Son Willis Rudnall
 Executors & Executors of this my last will &
 Testament in Witness whereof I have here
 unto set my hand and affixed my seale
