that is my and not sold my Son Thomas
Cattle also all my Hogs that is not called the same
& my Boarding Man & all my Household
Goods & other Summ & such as Tools & Cylinders
During her Widowhood or Life,
With Head of Sheep.

Item - I give to my Son Thomas Umphrey one
Hundred Acres of Land more or less lying
at a White Oak. Steeping out of the Miles
Creek & running a Direct Course to my
Back Line & Harrow Board & Saddle and
all my Cattle that is called by the Name of his
Cattle and all the Hogs that is called his name
and all the same

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I give unto my son John Humphrey ten
Pounds in Gold & Silver Coin

I give to my son Robert Humphrey ten Pounds
in Gold & Silver Coin

I give to my son Matthew Humphrey the Rans-
dom which I now live on during on Hundred
Acres that I gave before to my son Thomas

I give to my sons John & Robert & my Daughters
Elizabeth Mary and Patience all my Estate of what
sort or kind whatsoever it be to be Equally
Divided between them at the End of their
Mothers Death or Widowhood

I Appoint and Ordain my loving Wife Matthew
Humphrey and my Trusty Friend Joseph Howell
my Whole & Sole Exors. of this my Last Will and
Testament. and my Will and Desire is that my
Executor Joseph Howell take into his Hands the
money that I have given to my sons John
& Robert and apply it to the Use of purchasing
Land for my two sons John & Robert. Witness
my Hand and Affix
my Seal the 20th day of March 1662
