god do this 29th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty eight in considering the uncertainty of
my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will
and Testament in manner and form following that is to
say first that my Executor hereinafter named shall provide
for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my
relations and friends and pay all funeral expenses together
with my just debts hereunto due to whomsoever owing out
of the moneys that may first come into his hands as a
debt or part of my estate

I give and devise to my beloved wife Abigail Stewart
all my Land where I now live and all the lands that
I have deeds for together with houses and out houses
and other improvements to have and to hold unto
her the said Abigail Stewart at Adams my will that
my beloved wife shall have all my stock of horse or horses
and cows hogs sheep and poultry and all the grain
hay and every thing in my Possession to have and
to hold to her the said Abigail Stewart for and during
the term of her life for her satisfaction wholly I
do hereby constitute and appoint my son John Stewart
my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes to
execute this my last will and testament according
to the true intent and meaning of the same
and every part and clause hereof hereby revoking and
declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments
by me heretofore made, In witness whereof I the
said Jonathan Stewart do hereunto set my hand and
Seal this 29th day of July A.D. 1858 Signed sealed Published
and declared by the said Jonathan Stewart to be
his last will and testament in the Presence of us
who at his Request and in his Presence do subscribe
our names as witnesses thereto
