therefore make and appoint this my last will
And testament Revoking all will or wills by
me heretofore made or deeds of gifts of any
kind and declaring this and no other as
My last will and testament of them In the first Place I give my Soul to
God who gave it and my body to its mother
Dust and my worldly goods as follows
I give all my Property of every kind or sort
what so ever with all money due me in the hands
of any Person whatever to be equally Divided
By Sail between Lucy Brown Cloe Morris my
two Daughters and Henry Denton Cloe son
Betsey Dentons two boys namely Williamson
and Cordy them two to draw as one Part
With the other three and of their Part to be
Put on interest by the Executors till they shall
come to lawfull age and if one Should die without
lawful heir

The other to have his Part and if both should
Die without a lawful heir then the other three
Legatees to Devide it Equal between them
And lastly I appoint Calum Moore my
Executor to this my Last Will and Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and first my Seal this eighteenth day
of November 1815
