Charity Wood Flowers the Sum of Twenty five
Dollars in money or Bonds to her and her heirs forever. —

Item 6th my will and desire is that after my death that my
negro Man Philip one Sorrell Horse one Horse colt
all my Stock of Cattle Hogs and Sheep and all
my house hold ^{articles} furniture that I have not before disposed
of farming tools cart & wheels shall be sold at public
Sale as my Executor may think best also all of my
crop ~~and~~ provisions that may be on hand at
that time, and pay all of my Just debts out
of the moneys arising from said sale. —

Item 7th after all my Just debts are paid I
Give and Bequeath the balance of money that

may arise from said sale to my Son William
Crawford Moore to him and his heirs for ever.
Now my Will and desire is that provided Mourning
Sister William Crawford Moore and James
Howard Alford should die without any issue
that all the property I have given to
them should return back to my family and
be equally divided between them all.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my Son
Robert P. Moore Executor to this my Last Will
and Testament, truly Revoking all other
Wills by me made heretofore.
