and publish this my last will and testament  
my said I recommend to god that gare it my  
body I leauue to be buried at the discretion  
of my Executar in a decent manner and  
the propertie that it hath pleased the Lord to  
bless me with in this world I give and  
bequeath as follows (to wit) first taking into  
consideration the faythfullnes of my slave Charly  
through life I desire and do make provision for  
her comfort and liberation after my death therfor  
I leauue her in the care of my Executar to see  
to and govern as her guardian and leauue in  
his hand one hundred Dollars for her support  
in her old age and affliction to be used for  
her benefit and support at the discretion of  
my Executar and if the said slave Charly  
Shall die without being expences in the  
discretion of my Executar then the aboves hundred  
Dollars appropriated to her benefit to be devideed  
as hereafter desir'd and wishing to gratify  
my slave Charly and her children that she may  
have and all that she may have I leauue them  
to choose what they may choose to leue with of  
my death and for my Executar to choose  
three or five men of discretion disinterested  
with whom the said Charly may chuse to live  
with and for the said men to put a fair and  
moderat valuation on them and the chosen  
master take them at valuation provided he or  
she may be willing and to give bond and

such security as the Executor may require to  
the Executor on the same time that the Executor  
may give on the date of my other property  
and I leave to my Executor security piece of ten  
to give to myself for the benefit of her and herself  
than I give and bequeath to my Sister Mrs.  
William Harris wife one hundred Dollars  
and to my Sister Hester Morris pension of  
hundred Dollars if she is not living at my  
Death the above hundred Dollars to give and bequeath  
to Hester upchurch first wife during dependent  
body heirs and I give and bequeath to Eaton  
Upchurches wife ~~Morris~~ if she is living at my  
Death one hundred Dollars but if she is not  
living at my Death to her children and the  
balance of the money remaining after from  
the sale of property after paying all my just  
debts to be equally divided between Jas. Hart-  
field's first wife Martha's four children

William Hartfield William Ring's wife also  
~~Henry Page~~ and Mary Gibbs also the above  
named hundred Dollars mentioned for the use  
of Chang or any part of it that may not be  
used to her benefit to the said four last named  
children after Chang's Death  
and I constitute and appoint my friend  
Simon Williams Executor to this my last will  
and Testament in witness whereof I have here  
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this 21  
day of February in the year of our Lord 1840
