July in the year of our Lord 1816 make and publish
his my last will and testament in the manner
following that is to say -

1st I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth Perry
one Negro man named Simon and one named Peter
and a woman named Cook together with the balance
of my stock and house hold & kitchen furniture that
is left of paying my just Debts ^{to her} During her natural life
and after her death to be equally divided between my son John
and my Daughter Sally Jordons heirs -

2nd I give and bequeath unto my son John E. Perry three small
negroes names as follow Ester Sim and Bith also
the land where I now live supposed to be one hundred and
twenty acres -

3rd I have all ready give to my Daughter Sally Jordan one negro
Boy named Bob I also Give and bequeath to my Daughter
Sally Jordons heirs a Negro boy named Adam and a girl
named Siller -

And I hereby make and ordain my worthy
friend William Murphy and my son John B. Perry
executors of this my last will and testament in writing
whereof I the ^{Said} Burrill Perry have to this my last
will and testament set my hand and seal the
day and year above written. Burrill Perry ^{his} 
mark

will and testament in the presence of us who
were present at the time of signing and sealing
thereof. &c
