following (viz) First I lend unto my Daughter
Nancy Gant - the use of my House where I now
reside together with Twenty acres of Land ^{above}
the said House During her Single or married
life after which the said House and Land to
go as hereafter devised.

Item I give and Devise unto my son William
Gant - six Hundred acres of Land ^{more or less} It being the
Land whereon I now live, Bounded as follows
(viz) beginning in Cooper Williams line on
Redbud Creek thence along his line to Archer
Davis' line thence along said Davis' line
to the Road thence along the said Road to
Reubens meeting House thence running along
Collins' line its various courses to Redbud Creek
above the mill thence down the creek to the first
station, to him his heirs and assigns for ever

Item I give & Devise unto my son Jerry Gant
all the rest of my lands to him his heirs and
assigns forever

Item I give and Bequeath unto my
son Jordan Gant Five Hundred Dollars

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
Nancy Gant Four Negroes (viz) Old Ben Lilly,
and her child Robbin and Pat - to her and her heirs
and assigns for ever and no more of my estate
as witness my hand and seal this 13 day
of January 1816 — Charles Gant

Will and Testament to wit

It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be first
paid

I devise unto my Executors here after named the land
whereon I now live lying on Sandy Creek in the County
aforesaid to be by them sold on a credit of twelve months
and out of the money arising there from I give and bequeath
unto my wife Molly two hundred dollars I also give and
bequeath unto my said wife Molly the one half of my house-
hold Furniture and my cott named Lofly to her and her
Heirs for ever— I give to each of my sons to wit. Phaban
Thomas Howell Nathaniel and to each of my Daughters
Molly Turner and Betsy Carroll five shillings a piece—
I give unto my Son in law William Woodard the balance
of the money arising from the sale of my land my stock of
all kinds plantation Utensils and all the rest and residue
of my Estate he paying all my just debts.

It is my Will and desire that my Negro man Roger have
liberty to live where he pleases but be under the controul
and management of William Woodard

I hereby nominate Francis Pugh William Woodard and
Daniel Westrey Executors of this my last Will and Testa-
ment and do hereby revoke all Wills by me heretofore made
