I Charles A. Hill of the County of Franklin
State of North Carolina, being weak in body
but of sound & disposing mind, do make, ordain,
& constitute this my last Will & Testament in
manner following to wit,

1st I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Rebecca
Hill, one third part of my Lands together
with a Negro man by the name of
Reddick, and a Negro Woman by the name
of Charlott to her and her heirs forever.

2nd I give & confirm unto my Daughter Mary
Ann Malone all the property I have heretofore
given her & now in her possession to her &
her heirs forever.

3rd I give & bequeath to my five sons, David
S. Kemp P. Nicholas L. Richard & Charles
the residue of my Lands to be equally
divided among the same, and each to take
possession of his lot on his arriving to
lawful age to them & their heirs forever.

4th I give & bequeath all the balance of my
Estate of every kind, after paying my
last debts, to my said Wife Rebecca Hill.

and my seven youngest children to be equal
divided among the whole.

Item 5th = I hereby authorize my executors to sell such
portion of my stock of every kind and in
such way as they may think most expedient

Item 6th = I hereby nominate constitute and appoint
my Son Daniel P. Hill, and my friend
and relation Joel King Executors to this
my last will & Testament.
