

State of North Carolina Franklin County - Know all
men by these presents That I Leroy Andrews of the above
County & State, being of perfect mind & memory but
feeling some bodily indisposition and knowing the
uncertainty of human life do think proper to make this
my last will & Testament

In the first place I wish all my just debts paid
by my Executors - out my estate. -

Secondly - I give & bequeath to my son John P. Andrews
all the Land I have in Warren County where he lives
three hundred & fifty acres - to him & his heirs forever -
likewise I give to John P. Andrews one half of all the
negroes I now own - likewise one half of the am-
ount of the notes due me after my debts are paid -
= likewise a choir horse.

Thirdly - I give to William E. Andrews all the land
I now own in Franklin County to him & his heirs forever
- likewise one half of all the negroes I now own according
to valuation to him forever and one half of amount
of the notes due me at present - all the crop - stock
& household and kitchen furniture I give to the
said Mrs. Andrews. to him & his heirs. -

And I hereby constitute and appoint my two
sons John P. Andrews & Mrs. E. Andrews Executors
to this my will this the 13th of January 1843 - and
I have hereunto set my hand and seal.
