of the whole of my Estate both Real & personal As followeth (viz)

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son Shadrach Stallings ~~Twenty~~ ^{Twenty}
current money to him & his heirs forever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son Meshach Stallings Twenty
Shillings current money to him & his heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son Inlaw Daniel Sutherland Twenty
Shillings current money to him & his heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son Elijah Stallings Twenty Shil-
lings, to him & his heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Penelope May One Negro
freeman Named Kate with her two Children named Calany
& Sam to her & her heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son Elisha Stallings Forty Acres
of Land whereon he now lives, & One hundred Dollars to him & his
heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Delilah Williams One Negro
Girl of Six years Old During her life and after her Death
my will is that the said negroe with her increase shall be -
Equally Divided among all her Children to them & theirs for Ever

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son inlaw John Moody Twenty -
Shillings current money to him & his heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Winney Burns, One Negro
Girl Named Hannah to her & her heirs for Ever -

Item I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Casarahappuch Stone
One Negro boy Named Dick to her & her heirs for Ever -

Carried over -

Item I Give & bequeath Unto my Daughter Mortilly Stallings -
One Negroe Girl Named Lucy, & Twenty five pounds Virginia
Currency, One Feather bed & furniture & one Cow & calf to her & her heirs
for Ever

Item I lend Unto my Dearly beloved wife Anna Stallings my
Negroes Named Sampson & Lucy the s^d s^d over and, & as much
of my plantation as my Servs for her Use to live on & make
a Crop to Support on Reasonably, One feather bed & furniture
and Two Cows & Calves & two Sows & piggs During her natural
or Natural Life.

Item I lend to my Grandson Joseph Stallings the fenced Ground at my Old place whereon
my Son Eliza now lives for the term of twenty years Excepting the Orchard.

Item I Give and bequeath Unto my Son Reddick Stallings
All my Lands Except the lent of my wifes Use & also that of them
to my Grandson of the fenced Ground at my old plantation above
mentioned, the Orchard Excepted to my son Reddick Use, Also my
my Negroes as follows (wth) my negro man Namee, Prince, Judy
Elther, Ager, & young Judy, One feather bed & furniture, And all
the Remainder of my Stock of all kinds, As also after my loving
wifes Decease or widowhood, my Son shall have my Negroes
Sampson & Lucy to him & his heirs for Ever.

Item I Give & bequeath to my Grandson Burgess Moody One
feather & furniture And fifty dollars to him & his heirs for Ever

Item I Give, & bequeath to my Daughter Mortilly Stallings All the
Remainder of that part of my Estate which I have lent to
my wife, After her Death, to her & her heirs for Ever

I Likewise constitute Make and Ordain my Son in Law
William May & Joseph Eley my whole & sole Executors
of this my Last will & testament, And I do hereby Revocate
Disallow & Disannul all Other wills or testaments by me
here to fore made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal this 28th day of September 1795
