

In the name of God Amen I Griffin Wright
of the County of Franklin and State of North
Carolina being in perfect Mind and Memory
first committing my Soul to that God who
giveth and taketh at his pleasure do make
and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form as follows —

Item 1st I lend to my beloved Wife Delphia during
her natural life such of my real and personal
property as she may think proper to take

Item 2nd It is my will and desire that all my
Single Daughters have the liberty and privi-
lege of living and remaining in the House
with my wife as usual so long as they
may ~~live~~ live single together with half
this tract of Land

Item 3rd It is my desire also that all my Estate
be kept together untill my youngest Son
becomes of age or as my sons and Daughters
may marry or remove then and in that
care for them to have so much of my
estate as those of my Children who are married
have received to be allotted them by two
unconnected indifferent Men

Item 4th: It is my desire also that when my youngest son becomes of age that an equal division of such of my Estate as then may be taken place between all my Children making those who may not have received any thing fully equal with those who have now or those who may before that time ~~receive~~ have received of my property

Item 5th: I wish also that if any of my ~~Wife~~ misbehaves in such a manner as my wife may not like that they be sold by my Executors

Item 6th I nominate and appoint my sons Gideon George, Richard, Thomas and James my Executors to this my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 20th day of March 1871
