Estate Both Real and personal During her Natural life and after

her Decease all the Remainder of my whole Estate Both Real
and personal to be Sold to the Highest Bidder at the Discretion of

my Executors and the Monies arising from the Sale thereof to
be Equally Divided betwixt my four Children Sarah John Dennis

and Luinda and I doo appoint my two sons in law Demetrius
young and Stephen young the Executors of this my last will

and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this Ninth Day of December one Thousand Seven
