of Beaufort County and State of North Carolina being
in perfect health mind and memory. Not Calling to mind
the mortality of the body and the uncertainty of this
present life and knowing it appointed for men to die
do make and ordain this my last Will and
testament in the following manner that is first
I give and recommend my soul into the hands of my
Creator who give it to me and my body to the Earth
to be buried in a plain decent Christian like manner
at the discretion of my Executors here after mentioned
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the power of the
almighty god and as touching such worldly Estate where
with it hath pleased god to bless me with in this life
I give demise and dispose of it in the following form
and Manner —

1. I give and bequeath unto my son Joshua Jones
the following Negroes (to wit) J. Gallomas Amos Phair
Cary Kemp Patrick Mahaly and Thanner already
in his possession. Also Lady Ellen Henry Bob
Obern Billy Winney Rufin & Wesley, unto him his
Heirs and assigns for ever —

2. I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Jones my
Land and plantation where on I now live and all
my other Land not already given away unto him
unto him his Heirs and assigns for ever. Also the follow-
ing Negroes to wit Clay Buck Will Wells Ben
Thursday Gendison Wilson Nat. Pol. Betty Muley
Mingo Charlott & Mary and \$125 to him his
Heirs and assigns for ever —

Item 3rd It is my will and desire that the \$125 that
I gave to my son Jacob Jones be paid out of my
personal property - - - - -

Item 4th I give unto my gran son Jacob Jones son of
Council Jones and the following Negroes to wit
Milly Charles & Young unto him his heirs and
assigns for ever, ~~their increase~~ to him for ever

Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my gran son Allen
Jones one Negroe boy name Wata always in his
possession unto him his heirs & assigns for ever -

Item 6th My will and desire is that my set of black
smiths tools my stock of Horses Cattle & Hogs be
Equally divided between my two sons Joshua Jones
and Jacob Jones. Also my still house houts and Kitchen
furniture my plantation Utensell of all kinds be Equally
divided between my two sons Joshua & Jacob Jones

Item 7th My will and desire is that my old Negroe woman
Jey is not to belong to any of my children. It is my
Will that my sons Joshua & Jacob Jones maintain
the said old Negroe during her life and that she
may Live with either of them as long as she lives -

I do hereby nominate and appoint my two sons
Joshua & Jacob Jones my whole and sole Executors
to this my Last Will and Testament revoking all
other Wills by me heretofore made - In Witness here of
I have set my hand and seal this 11th day April 1846
