do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is
to say first of all I Recommend my soule in to the hands of god
Almighty that gave it and my body I Recommend to the earth
to be buried at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again
As touching such worldly estates where with it has pleased god
Almighty to bless me with in this life therefore I give and dispose
of the same in the following manner

I leave the hole of my estate to my wife her life time and after her
death in the following manner

I then I give and bequeire to my son Benjamin Arundell one feather bed
and furniture and all the rest of my estate that he has in his possession
At this time to be possessed by him and his heirs and assigns for Ever

I then I give and bequeire to my Daughter Ann Charles Twenty Shilling
And all the rest of my Estate that she has in her possession at this time to
be possessed by her and her heirs and assigns for Ever

I then I give and bequeire to my Daughter Elizabeth Price all the
rest of my estate Except one Cow I leave to my grand son Benjamin
Price to be possessed by him and all the rest with all that she has in her
possession to be possessed by him and his heirs and assigns for Ever

And I do declare all these will or well legeses bequeather rights
Or downies this to be my last will and testament Given under
my hand and Seal this twenty third day of March in year 1794
