

In the name of God Amen I James Barrow of the
County of Franklin & State of North Carolina, being of
sound mind & disposing memory do hereby declare
this my last Will & Testament, to wit,

First. My Will is that all my just debt, be first paid

2nd My wish & desire is that my Executors hereafter to be
named sell the whole of my Estate both Real and
Personal in such way and manner as they may
think most beneficial to the several Legatees hereafter
named:

3rd The profits arising from the sale of said Real and
Personal Estate be divided as follows to wit,

My beloved Wife Mary Barrow to have one eighth
of the profits arising from the sale of my Estate and
then my Children to wit, Mary Barrow, Susannah
Winston, Elizabeth Barrow, James Barrow, William

T Barrow and Martha Barrow each to have one
eighth of the said profits, and my three Grand
Children to wit, Elizabeth A Barrow, John Barrow &
Mary T Barrow the Children of my Dec^d Son
Edmond Barrow to have the other eighth to be equally
divided between them; nevertheless there must be

deducted from Susannah Winston's eighth or por-
tion Two Hundred dollars, from James Barrow's part

or share fifty dollars and from the part or share of
my said three Grand Children one hundred dollars

4th I give unto William Smith, Sarah Smith &
John Smith the children of Lawrence & Nancy H.
Smith fifty dollars each to be put out at Interest for
those of them who may be under age until they marry
or do come of age.

5th My two Executors are to lay off and set a part my year
maintenance sufficiently to support my Wife and
those of the family who may be single or reside with
my Wife.

6th I hereby appoint my son James Barrow and my
friend James J. Hill my Executors, with power to
sell & settle the Estate without any order from Court,
to this my last Will & Testament revoking all others
In witness whereunto I set my Hand & Seal this the
fifteenth day of July Anno Domini 1816
