

In the name of god Amen. I, Jeremiah Perry of the County of Franklin
North Carolina, doth this twenty fifth day of January eighteen hundred
& thirty eight make, publish & declare this my last will & Testament
hence revoking & superseding all others heretofore made by me.

I Loan to my beloved wife Temperance during her natural life -
six hundred acres of land, where she may prefer, out of all my Lands
lying on Cedar Creek & its waters with every thing belonging or appertaining
to the same, also one half of the profits of my mill & cotton gin.

I give unto my said wife Temperance the following negroes & all increase
from this time, Negroes, (Big Jacob, Little Jacob, Big Jim) Edmund, Minor, Harry
son of Oliver, Coky, Handy, old Peter, old Peter, Gold morning, & all my
household & kitchen furniture consisting of Birds & every thing else belong-
ing to or in my house, &c. all my Stock of Horses, cattle, sheep, mules, & hogs,
all my plantation Tools of every sort, carts wagons, & Blacksmith tools,
to her & her heirs forever

I give Elizabeth unto all the children of my son Nathan Perry dead, the
whole of the Tract of Land wherein my said Son live, which Land I purchased
has of Benjamin F. Hawkins & every thing belonging thereto, supposed to
contain eight hundred Acres, more or less, also all the negroes which
is in the possession of my said Sons heirs, which were put in his possession
by & coming from me & all increase from the time of said possession
& forever, also, Negroes, Serena, Jordan, Betsy, Mingo & Pippy, with
all increase from this time & all other property which is in their
possession that come by & through me including every sort whatever
to them & their heirs forever,

I give & bequeath unto my son Bennett Perry the whole of the Tract
of Land, lying on Synches Creek which I purchased of Epp Moody -
with every thing belonging thereto, also all the negroes which he has in
his possession which come by & through me, & all increase from the
time of said possession & forever, also, Negroes, Hannah, Horace,
Davy, Daniel & Cook & all increase from this time, & all other
property which is in his possession, that come by & through me, to
him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son Willie Perry, all the negroes which
is in his possession which came by & through me & all increase from
the time of said possession & forever, also Negroes Dick, Casper,
Harriet, Noeflet, & Sam, & all increase from this time & all
other property which is in his possession that come by me of every
sort to him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son Reddin Perry, the whole of the Land
whereon he now lives, which Land I purchased of Henry Williams
& Joshua Fowler, & every thing belonging thereto, also, Negroes, Austin,
Stephen, Hamp, Zippah, Coky, (young Peter) Eller, Peyton, Elliott &
Haywood, & all increase from this time & all other property which
is in his possession that come by & through me to him & his heirs
forever.

I give & bequeath unto my son Henry Perry the whole of the said Land on which he now lives, in the county of Halifax, N.B. which Land I purchased of George Pothick with every thing belonging thereto also Negroes, Vinyl, Ben, Isaac, Ephraim, Warwick Lewis, Battie Fanny, Sally, Wimby, Washington, Bristol, (young Olivia) & all the and all increase from this time. & all other property which he has in possession that come by & through me to him & his heirs forever.

I give & bequeath unto my son Sidney Perry the whole of the said Town on Cedar Creek & its waters, reserving to my wife 40 Acres which I have bequeathed to her for life as above. & after the death of my said wife I hereby give unto my sd son Sidney the whole & the land bequeathed to my said wife as above named with every thing belonging or appertaining thereto & every thing belonging to the whole of my lands on Cedar Creek & its waters also negroes, Vinyl, Barbara, Dupper, Simon, York, Lydia, Mandie, Ben (son) Richard, Motley, Rashel, (Jacob, son of Hall) Frank, Dicey, George, Amos, Eaton, Bottling Aaron, Battie, & (Ben Pace) & all increase from this time to him & his heirs forever.

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Betsy Conyers all the property she has in her possession that come from & through me & all increase from the time of said bequeath & former & all other property which she has in possession that come from me & all increase from this time to her & her heirs forever.

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Chloe Neal, all the property she has in her possession that come by & through me & all increase from the time of said bequeath & former & all other property which she has in her possession that come by me also negroes, George, Ceasy, & Eliza, & all increase from this time to her & her heirs forever.

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Temperance Perry (Tempo, Harry, Charlotte, Alice, Frances, Fannie, Vinyl, Abram, Ben & Maria) & all increase from this time & also One thousand Dollars, to her & her heirs forever.

And as to the balance of my Estate consisting in what it may be real, personal, or mixed, of every sort whatever, I wish to be divided between my sons Bennett, Willie, Addison, Sidney & Henry Perry, to be under the entire control & management of my sons Bennett & Willie Perry, for them to do what to them shall seem to be fair, Just, & Right, and I do hereby

Nominate & appoint my sons Bennett, Perry & Willie Perry Executors to this my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have caused to be made & affixed my seal day & date above written,
