publish this my last will and testament in
manner and form following, that is to say first
I give and bequeath unto my son William
Leonard one Negro man by the name of Ed. Pompey
one Negro boy by the name of Pompey one negro girl
by the name of Mary to him and his heirs for
ever also I give and Bequeath to my Son Frederick
Leonard one negro woman by the name of Rachel
one negro man by the name of Abram one Boy
By the name of Jell one By the name of Jim
one negro girl By the name of St. Rachel
and the Land and Plantation where on I now live
to him and his heirs for ever I also
give to my Daughter Elizabeth Blanchet one
negro girl by the name of Peribby to her and
her heirs for ever also I give to my Daughter
Mary Leonard one negro boy by the name of Urdy
to her and her heirs for ever I also give to my
grand son John Leonard the son of William Leonard
one negro man by the name of Redick to him and his
heirs forever I also leave all my stock of hogs and
cattle and horses corn house hold furniture to be
equally divided between my two sons William and
Frederick Leonard at My Decease

I have by appointed My too sons William & Frederick
Leonard Executors of this My last will and Testament
hereby Revoking all former wills and Testaments by
me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this Tenth Day of October 1842
