 tract of Land whereon I now live together with every
 benefit & Advantage there unto belonging during her
 life: also I give ^{my} black mare named diamond saddle & bridle
 to her & her heirs for ever - also I give her two Cow &
 Calves - also as many Hogs as will support her the ensuing
 year together with two sows & piggs also as much of my
 Crop of Corn & fodder as shall be sufficient to serve her
 one year - also I give her one bed & furniture - also I lend
 her one bed & furniture - which is to ^{my son} Washington at
 her discretion - or at her death - also two Yewes & Lambs
 also as many Hoes & Axes as will support the plantation
 also all kind of fowls - also all household stuff my wife
 brought with her except such things as she has made use
 of - also I lend her my Chest of drawers - also I lend her
 one small trunk - also it is my wish that my wife have
 as much Money out of my Estate as shall give her
 tolerable good negroes to work in the field for two
 years - also one D... to be given

I then I give & bequeath my land at my death to my
two daughters namely Elizabeth & Mary to be
sold & Equally divided between the two

Also it is my wish and desire that my two Negroes
sold at twelve month's C^t to gether with all my stock
of Cattle hogs & horses with my house & kitchen
furniture & plantation utensils and the money
to be divided Equally between my five Children

Except one young horse to James Murphy son of my
wife

Lastly I do ordain and Appoint my beloved son
Michael Pinnell & my friend Mr. D. Thomas my
true & lawful Exors to Act and do agreeable to this
my last will & testament
Signed, sealed and declared and
published by John Pinnell as his
last will & testament and signed
with his own hand on each page this
this 6th day of March 1813 in pre
