Item I bequeath my wife Mary Pulliam during  
her widowhood every thing that I shall die

after her widowhood I give to my son Pulliam one to him  
& his heirs for ever & as much,

Item I give & bequeath to my son Nelson one  
dollar & no more to him & his heirs for ever

Item I give to my son Abby one dollar to him &  
his

& heirs for ever (4 no more)

I give & bequeath to my son Allen one dollar and as soon to him & his heirs for ever

I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Elliot one dollar & as soon to her & her heirs for ever

I give & bequeath to my

son Kinchen thirteen dollars to him & his heirs for ever

I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Rush one dollar & as soon to her & her heirs for ever

I give & bequeath to my son Sock with W. Pulliam one half of the tract of Land which I now live on to him & his heirs for ever

I give & bequeath to my son John G. Pulliam the other half of the same tract of Land to gether with all my stock of Horses cattle hogs & sheep House hold & Kitchen Furniture after paying the before mentioned Legacies to him & his heirs for ever

The before mentioned Legacies amount to eighteen dollars that is given in money and I do hereby here by nominate & appoint my son John G. Pulliam my Executor of this my Last will and Testament working all others ~~to~~ signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
