I John Sutherland of the County of Franklin  
in State of North Carolina do appoint and  
constitute this my last Will & Testament.

Item 1<sup>st</sup> It is my desire that my Expenses out of  
the nett proceeds of the crops to be raised  
for the present year should make the necessary  
arrangements to satisfy all my just and indulgent  
creditors.

Item 2<sup>d</sup> All my lands and negroes are to be kept  
together under good orders to be employed from  
time to time by my Executor and brought from  
year to year as may best conduce to the interest  
of my Wife & children, the nett proceeds of  
every crop to be placed entirely at the disposal  
of my Wife during the term of her natural  
life or so long as she remains my Widow to  
be disposed of by her in no other way but for  
the equal benefit of herself & my two sons, etc  
which dispositions of money by her is to be made  
by & with the advice of my Executor.

Item 3<sup>d</sup> It is expressly enjoined as a duty on my  
Executor that as soon as my Wife may think proper  
to depart from her Milkwheel they are to convey  
& dispose of all her Interest and right in  
any part of my estate, but so long as she  
remains my Widow she is to stand upon the  
feeling of a child inheriting one third part of  
both personal & real property during the term  
of her natural life, which property at her death  
is to revert equally to my children, but should  
any of my children take (which may God of his  
mercy forbid) an immoral Spendthrift and  
unhappy course then and in that case she is  
hereby vested with a discretionary power to give  
or withhold from that child & the my  
think proper, pecuniary sum arising from such child to be off set.

hereby the whole of such property as hereby  
left to her at the close of her life or inheritance  
Item 4<sup>th</sup> It is my Will that should it be  
the will of God to take my two sons out  
of time before they become of age or have  
Lawfull Spous that then & in that case  
my wife if living is to have the sole &  
exclusive benefit of the whole of my estate  
both real & personal during the term of her  
natural life & at her death it is my will  
that an equal moiety thereof is to be disposed  
by her as she may think proper the other half  
to settle on & descend to John Ransom Wilson  
or his living the eldest son of my sister Sarah Wilson  
now of Kentucky.

Item 5<sup>th</sup> It is my will and desire that my wife  
or executors as the case may be, be authorized to  
sell for money either at private or publick sale  
my pigs & hams & with the moneys arising from  
such sale my executors are to purchase for  
the comfort & benefit of my family such a  
carriage as my wife may direct or the estima-  
tion of my estate about of

Item 6<sup>th</sup> It is my Will that my executors pay the  
most early & prompt attention to the securing & collecting  
of a debt due from Littlebury & May & Little-  
bury as soon as the same may become due & paying the  
money & every part thereof to the debtor for  
a debt due, over Eliza S. Atkinson.

Item 7<sup>th</sup> It is my desire that my wife & executors  
sell & dispose of a lot of land she inherited  
of her deceased brother Loty Atkinson lands lying in  
the County of Warren, & such sale to be good  
& valid in law to all intents & purposes as if  
made by myself in person & in due form  
& the money arising from such sale to be applied

in the payment for shares or parts unpaid  
in the Lewis Land or expended in the op-  
ening the present dwelling house.

By £750 am requested to be specially at-  
tive to the securing as the Law direct  
the title to the shares yet undivided in  
the Lewis Land to my heir, to gett al my  
debs of record, & deposit them with my ap-  
pointed attorney. So long as my wife may live she is hereby  
made & constituted Testamentary guardian to  
my two sons, & in case of her death my  
well beloved & trusty friend Henry Goddard  
humbly appointed her successor.

Lastly I do thirby nominate & app-  
oint my well beloved & trusty friends Henry  
Goddard & William Phillips as Excs to this my  
Last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all  
other by me heretofore made, declareth  
publishing this only as my Last, In testimo-  
ny of which I have hereunto set my hand  
& seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1815.
