Joth this the fifteenth of Day of March in the year of our Lord
1804 Make and ordain this my Last will and testament
in Manner and form as following to wit I then give and bequeath
to my brother Samuel Taylor one negroe Man by the name
of Tobb I also give and bequeath unto the said Samuel
Taylor one hundred acres of Land that was given to me
by the will of Dred Taylor Lying on the waters of Turkey
Creek I give and bequeath unto Boykin Taylor one
negroe boy by the name of Hardy until my mothers Death
I give and bequeath unto my brother Hardy Taylor one negro
boy by the name of Ely until my Mother Death my will
and Desire is that after my Mother Death that the negro
property that was sent to my mother and given to me by my
father that after my mother Death that there may be
a Equal Divide be tween Hardy Taylor & Boykin
Taylor of the said I give and bequeath unto Hardy Taylor
and Boykin Taylor two hundred acres of Land to be
Equally Divide between them that my father give to me in
his will also my Desire is that the Rest of my
property be sold and that all my Debt & Lawful
Dets be paid and the Balance be Divide between my Brothers
Samuel Taylor Hardy Taylor Boykin Taylor

Hammonds Executors to this my Last will and testament
I promise this to be my Last will and testament and notes
