Polly Williams Each of them one bed and furniture a piece
to them and their heirs forever. But if either of my above
Named Daughters, should die without an heir, it is
then my will and desire that their bed and furniture
left to them be sold the money equally divided among
my other four children, also I give unto my son Jonathan
Williams, one bed and furniture to him and his heirs for
ever, and after my Decease it is my will and desire
for all my stock, of Horses, Cattle and Hogs to be sold
to the highest bidder on a lawfull credit, and also all
my working tools, and all my household and kitchen
furniture of every kind, and description whatsoever
to be sold on the above terms, also the tract and plan-
tation of Land whereon I now live, containing one Hundred
Acres, to be sold on the above motion, terms of credit, the
whole to be sold by my Executors and the monies
arising from the sales of the above land and other
property, to pay over to my three Daughters above named
and my son Jonathan Each to make their parts
Equal with what I have heretofore given unto my son
Benjamin Williams, and after they receive that sum

then all the remaining monies that may still be in the
 hands of our executor or executors as he can may be please
 to be equally divided be tween My five children
 to wit Benjamin, Jonathan, Wm. Fred, Lucy, and Polly
 Williams, also I give unto my Grand son George Harvise
 Williams, son of my son Benj^m and Rhode Williams
 one bed and furniture, and in case of his Decease under
 age then the real his of my son Benj^m whether male
 or female to his the he. and I do hereby recall and
 revoke all other Wills or bequests by me made and acknow
 ledge this and moother to be my last will and testam
 ent in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and fiat my seal this 23 sept 1710
