this time weak in body, but in perfect mind and memory
do make and ordain this my last will and testament
in manner and form following, as to my body, I leave
to be buried in decent Christian like manner, at the
option of my Executors, and my soul I commit
to the care of my gracious and merciful Creator
nothing doubting that I shall receive it again at the
general Resurrection of the Dead, and as to worldly
property where with it hath pleased God to bless me
with in this life, I give, bequeath, and devise in the
manner and form following, that is I give and bequeath
the unto my three Daughters thenceforth Lucy and
Polly Williams each of them one bed and furniture a piece
to them and their heirs forever, but if either of my above
Named Daughters, should die without an heir, it is
then my will and desire that they bed and furniture
left to her be sold the money equally divided among
my other four children, also I give unto my son Jonathan
Williams, one bed and furniture to him and his heirs fore
ever, and after my Decease, it is my will and desire
for all my stock, of Horses, cattle and Hogs, to be sold
to the highest bidder on a lawfull credit, and also all
my working tools, and all my household and kitchen
furniture of every kind, and description whatsoever
to be sold on the above terms, also the tract and plan
tation of land wherein I now live, containing one hundred
acres, to be sold on the above mention terms of credit, the
whole to be sold by my Executors and the monies
arising from the sale of the above land and other
property, to pay over to my three Daughters above named
and my son Jonathan fifty Dollars each to make their parts
equal with what I have heretofore given unto my son
Benjamin Williams, and after they receive that sum

then all the remaining monies that may still be in the
hands of my executors or executors as he can may be pleased
to be equally divided between my five children
to wit Benjamin, Jonathan, Winifred, Lucy, and Polly
Williams, also I give unto my grand son George Harrold
Williams, son of my son Benjamin and Rhoda Williams
one bed and furniture and in case of his decease under
age then the next heir of my son Benjamin whether male
or female to him the bed and I do hereby declare and
desire all other wills or bequests by me made or about
written this and another to be my last will and testament
and in witness whereof have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 29 sept 1810
