of body but of sound and perfect mind and memory
blessed be God for the same do make and publish this my
last will and testament in a manner and form following
(that is to say) First I give and bequeath unto my nephew
Archibald Yarbrough the whole of the tract of land whereon
I now live and the money for which I have a deed of trust
on John Sandlings land to him and his heirs forever
Also I give and bequeath unto my niece Nancy Yarbrough
one negro woman named China to her and her heirs forever.
I also give and bequeath unto Martha Allen (daughter of
Stokes Allen) one negro woman by the name of Dilly to her
and her heirs forever.

I also give and bequeath unto my nephew Young Allen
one negro woman named Nica to him and his heirs forever

I also give and bequeath unto Thomas C. Yarbrough (son of
Archibald Yarbrough) one negro boy named Lewis to him
and his heirs forever.

I also give and bequeath unto my niece Delcy Yarbrough
(daughter of James Yarbrough dead) one negro girl named
Lucia to her and her heirs forever

I also give and bequeath unto my nephew Archibald Yar-
brough one negro boy named Hampton to him and his
heirs forever.

I also give and bequeath unto my niece Nancy Yarbrough
one negro woman named Cherry and one negro boy named
Mitchel to her and her heirs forever.

I also leave the balance of my estate of whatever kind to be sold
and if there should be anything left after paying my debts
the remainder to be equally divided among my above mentioned
Legatees. Lastly I do hereby appoint my nephew Ar-
chibald Yarbrough sole Executor to this my last will & testament
hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In Witness

A Certificate of the Verbal or Nuncupative Will of
James Young Esq. agreeable to the Relation of the
undersigned Witnesses (Wiz) he gave his wife one hundred
acres of land to be laid off to her where she might think
proper on any Corner or End of his land with a Maintenance
for herself and youngest daughter Anney out of the profits
arising from his Estate which profits is to arise in a
manner hereafter to be directed also household & Kitchen
furniture sufficient for their accomodation in housekeeping
All the Ballance of his property negroes and all with
his White boys now under age to be put into the hands of
his Executor who is to be Joseph Young who is to keep the
Estate all together and work the negroes and boys on his
land as he may think most proper for the benefit and
advancement of the Estate and for his Estate and boys to
be directed and governed by the said Joseph Young his Ex^r
at his discretion untill his youngest son Joseph does
arrive to twenty one years of age after then as soon as can
with Convenience to notify all his Children Elizabeth
Hargrove Baxter Banister Bevilley, Abigail Williams
Benjamin Isham Thomas Joseph and Anney and his wife
all to attend at the manor plantation where they are
to proceed to divide the whole Estate increase profits and
all into Eleven Equal parts or divisions one for Each of
the above Children and one for his wife Exclusive of the
property ^{from to her} the Children who have already received
any part of ^{his} property to render an account of the
same which is ^{to be} valued to them as near as the Value can
be ascertained and put to their account as Evidence
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
