also at the same time one negro woman named
Pallan & her increase to be equally divided among
or between my above mentioned sons & daughters
also three negroes (to wit) Harry Jack & Asham
to be equally divided amongst or between my
Daughters & son Williamson to them & their Heirs for ever
I then Give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Murphy one Bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs for ever
I give & bequeath to my Daughter Patience
Murphy one Bed & Furniture to her for ever
I then Give & bequeath to my Daughter Anna
Murphy one Bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs for ever

I am I give & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy
Murphy one Bed & furniture to her & her heirs for ever
