ing mind and Memory, have made and declared
this my last will and Testament in manner and
form following, hereby Revoking all other Wills
heretofore made by me —

First I Give to Lurency Wymore one Acre, To Her
and her Heirs forever —

Secondly I Give to my sister Mary Howell Fifty Dol-
lars, Four Beds and all my Bed covering furni-
ture, and all my wearing apparel, and my
will and desire is, If my said sister Mary
should die before I do, that then and in that case
the Property hereby devised to Her and her Heirs
forever, go to and descend to her issue, to them
and their Heirs forever —

Thirdly I Give to my Brother Jeremiah Perry all
my Negro Slaves to wit, Sam, Hall, Charles, Rhoda,
Mourning, Winney, Little Sam, Henderson, Lewis,
Ramp, Nancy, Reuben, Anthony, Spencer, and
Sulford, with their Increase, Together with every
species of my property of whatsoever description
or kind, not above devised, and my will and
desire is, If my said Brother Jeremiah should
die before I do, that then and in that case, the
Property of every Description which is hereby
devised to him, and his Heirs forever, go to and
descend to his Children, to them and their Heirs
forever —

And lastly I Nominate and appoint my Brother Jeremiah
Perry, and Allen Perry his son, Executors to this my
last Will and Testament, In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st of February
