do make and publish this to be my last will &
Testament in the following manner to wit, first
I direct my Executor herein after named to pay
and satisfy all my debts out of my Estate as
soon as so much thereof can be collected, secondly
as I have given my Son Archibald one hundred &
fifty acres of land on the south of my house
(Deeded) I will to my Son Elias one hundred &
fifty acres on the north including his house &
then I will and bequeath to my Wife Amy one
hundred & fifty acres lying between my James lands
to have during her life after her decease to be
Equally divided between my Sons Archibald & Elias
then I will to my Wife Amy during her life or
widowhood Mony, Jewels, & Furrery to remain in
Franklin County, and not to be carried out
of said County, then two Beds & furniture the
old mare bridle & saddle three bows & balns
and the ballance of my Estate for my Executor
to sell and at my wifes decease to pay to
my Daughter Malinda Crossland Fifty Dollars
then to my Daughter Wimpy Bridges Ten Shillings
then All the overplus of sales, Bonds & mony
to be divided between my Wife Archibald & Elias
then All that my wife dies possessed of to be
Equally divided between my Two Sons

Archibald & Elias Wiggins my Two Sons
having their part here to fair mention
I do hereby constitute and Appoint my Son
Archibald Wiggins Executor of this my
will and Testament, In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this Eighteenth day of October One Thousand
Eight hundred and fifteen
