family I also appoint my father Levey
Brown Executor of this my last will
& testament in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this the
4 day of April in the year of our
Lord 1836 —

I Samuel Buffum knowing the mortality of my body
and being under heavy affliction at this time in my
body but being of sound and disposing mind and
memory do make and ordain this my last will and
testament in manner and form as follows —

My will and desire is that all my Estate Real and
Personal shall be kept together under the care
of my Executors that I shall hereafter appoint until
after my present crop that is now growing is made
and saved then after laying off a sufficiency for
the support of my wife Paddy and Children one good
the balance (that I shall not hear after my death
and lend to their use) to be sold to the best
advantage to pay the first bond that becomes due
I have I suppose now hold a gainst me then for
so much of my land to be sold to the best
advantage beginning on the south side of
my land and running North as will pay the other
two bonds that I have I suppose hold a gainst me
for the payment of my land —

I then

I give and bequeath to my wife Paddy one fourth part
of my land that will remain useful to me and
her heirs for ever

I lend to my wife Paddy and to my three children to wit
Robert Paul and Paddy Buffum to them and their use
until the three above children become of lawful
age my two mares and two cows to go with all
my house hold kitchen furniture and working tools
