Test: 2.nd It is my Will & desire, & I do so order
& direct, that my Executors herein after named,
sell, at Public or private Sale, according to
their discretion, the whole of the residue of
my Estate both Real & Personal; and out
of the proceeds thereof, that they pay & satisfy
all of my just debts, and the residue of such
proceeds, together with such debts as may be due
and owing to me, I Will devise & bequeath
to be equally divided between my two children
to wit, Margaret C. Connolly & Patrick Connolly
to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Section 3.rd. Out of the Confidence that I
have in my beloved Wife Polly Greenleaf,
my friends William Green & Green Hill
I hereby nominate constitute Appoint them
Executors & Executors of this my last Will
& Testament, - revoking all other Wills by
me heretofore made and declaring this to be
my last Will & Testament.
